St Dunstan's - Offertory Envelopes

New boxes of offertory envelopes, for the year commencing on 3rd June, are now available for collection in the front porch. Spare boxes are available for any parishioners who would like to start using offertory envelopes. Offertory giving may also be done by standing order, if preferred. Forms, with the parish bank details already included, are available in the front porch; these should be completed and then sent to your own bank. We would encourage all taxpayers who use envelopes or standing orders for their offertory giving to sign a Gift Aid Declaration (GAD) in order to allow the parish to reclaim the income tax associated with their giving. This provides St Dunstan's with an additional £5,000 each year. Copies of the GAD form are also available; when completed, they should be returned to the Parish Office or to Dave Rollison, the parish Gift Aid administrator.

Unwanted Clothing and Bedding for Mary's Meals

Mary's Meals are coming to our parishes in a couple of weeks' time to take away unwanted clothing and bedding (**no duvets or pillows please**). Over the next few weeks, please collect your unwanted clothes and put them in tied sacks. Then bring them to Mass with you **over the weekend of 2nd/3rd June**.
