Day for Life

this weekend focuses on Human Trafficking. Trafficking is a growing problem and the UN estimates that over 40 million people worldwide are in slavery. In the UK alone, it is estimated that, every year, there are over 13,000 victims of trafficking from all countries. The Catholic community can make a real difference to help solve this problem – to help them find freedom and live life to the full. There are many organisations working to put a stop to human trafficking and modern slavery.
