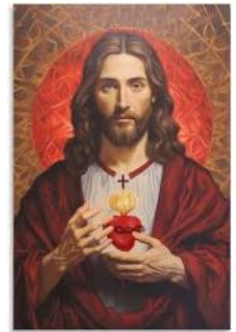

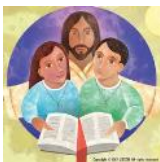

When Pope Benedict visited the UK in 2010, he used as his theme a phrase from St John Henry Newman, Cor ad cor loquitur—heart speaks to heart. It was a good phrase to use not just because the Holy Father came to speak to our hearts, but also because the highlight of his visit was the beatification of Cardinal Newman at Coton Park. June is the month in the Church's year dedicated to the Sacred Heart. The Sacred Heart of Jesus is a powerful symbol of His profound love for humankind demonstrated by His Willingness to sacrifice His life for our sake. The love from His heart motivated all His actions and the purpose of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is to focus our hearts on receiving and returning His love with gratitude—with all our heart, soul and strength. Perhaps you might like to make use of this prayer to the Sacred Heart during this month of June:



'O most holy heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore You, I love You and with lively sorrow for my sins I offer you this poor heart of mine. Make me humble, patient, pure and wholly obedient to Your will. Grant, good Jesus, that I may live in You and for You. Protect me in the midst of danger. Comfort me in my afflictions. Give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs. Your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death. Amen'
